## How to reach Ghent?

Ghent is easily reachable by train from Bruges, Antwerp or Brussels (Midi (connection with Thalys), Central, Nord, Brussels airport). For more information about the train, go the website of the [NMBS](#) (railway service). The easiest way to go to the faculty of economics or to the accommodation is to take the train to the “Gent Sint-Pieters” station (see **red circle** on map below). This is the main station of the city and strongly connected with public transport. There are also taxis waiting at the main exit of the train station. If you walk from the train station to the Faculty of Economics or the housing department it will only be about 20 minutes. (see map)

## How to reach the rooms?

We expect you to check in on Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> of August, in the afternoon.

*The housing facility is only 5 minutes walk from the faculty of economics. (see **brown circle** on the map)*

## Itinerary for the Faculty of Economics and Business Administration or the Housing department (both are very close to each other)

### BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT

From Gent Sint-Pieters railway station (red circle on the map):

- Tramway **1** direction Korenmarkt until the stops 'Veergrep' or 'Verlorenkost' (5 min. by foot from the faculty).
- Busses **42** or **44** (take at the bus platform 10 on Gent-Sint-Pieters railway station, stop on Sint-Pietersplein).

## Where are the lectures?

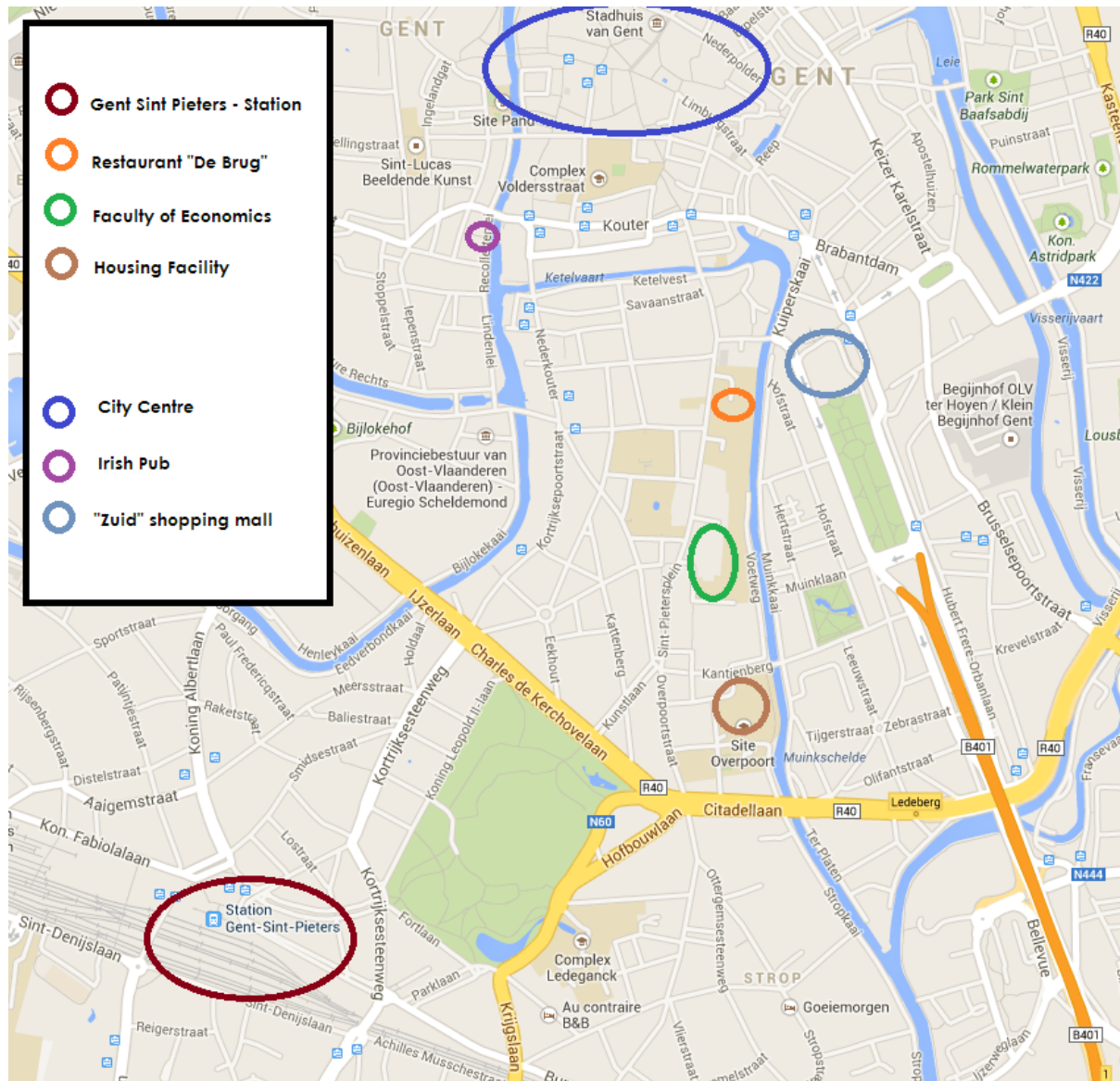
## Where is the conference dinner?
